### **Matters raised by the residents' present**

No residents were present.

### **Ward Councillors Report**

Cllr R. Ogg gave the following report:

- The Ward and Parish Councillors expressed their sadness over the news of Captain Sir Thomas Moores death and gave their condolences for his family.
- The gully at the bottom of Suttons Hill has been sucked out as it is full of leaves. The Council agreed to ask the Handyman to continue clearing it out as needed. An inspection has been carried out and the Ward Councillors are awaiting the results.
- The Parish Council discussed the hedge on PROW WINT178. The Clerk is to check who is to be cutting the hedge. The Clerk has obtained quotes for the hedge cutting and is to send them to North Lincolnshire Council.
- It was agreed that Cllr D. Fagan is to write to Colin Wilkinson at North Lincolnshire Council regarding the width of the PROW WINT178. Cllr D. Fagan also asked for further clarification regarding who is liable for what under the new devolution of responsibilities. Cllr R. Ogg is to ask Becky McIntyre at North Lincolnshire Council to send further information on this matter.
- North Lincolnshire Council have confirmed that the Parish Council would have to pay for the installation of an ornamental street light on Jubilee Gardens. However North Lincolnshire Council may have an unused ornamental street light that the Parish Council could use. The street light could also be used to power Christmas Lights. The Clerk is to obtain costs for the installation of the street light.

### **Business of the meeting of the Parish Council**

#### **1. Apologies for absence**

#### **2. To review the minutes of the meeting held on 5<sup>th</sup> January 2021**

Cllr D. Fagan proposed to accept the minutes of the meeting as an accurate record and Cllr M. Blackburn seconded. All were in favour and the minutes were approved.

#### **3. To consider the Clerks report**

##### **a) Ongoing items:**

- The Clerk confirmed that all items were ongoing with nothing further to update on.

- b) Environment Agency (EA) and Flooding: Cllr D. Fagan has responded to the A1077 Road Closure Consultation on behalf of the Parish Council. The Parish Council discussed the Road Closure on Ermine Street that is coinciding for a short time with the A1077 road closure.

4. To be updated on the financial report:

- a) To consider the monthly report: The Parish Council discussed the report and all payments were approved.  
It was agreed that the Financial Report is to be sent out with the Agenda.

5. To consider the following planning applications:

- a) PA/2020/1962: Planning permission for a change of use of outbuildings from ancillary residential accommodation to 2 new dwellings including extensions, alterations and the demolition of a single storey store at Scarborough House, 11 Silver Street, Winteringham, DN15 9ND: No negative comments were made.
- b) PA/2021/64: Listed building consent for a change of use of outbuildings from ancillary residential accommodation to 2 new dwellings including extensions, alterations and the demolition of a single storey store at Scarborough House, 11 Silver Street, Winteringham, DN15 9ND: No negative comments were made.
- c) PA/2021/42: Notice of intention to fell an ash tree within Winteringham's conservation area at Paddock House, 14 Silver Street, Winteringham, DN15 9ND: No negative comments were made.
- d) PA/2021/88: Application for a non-material amendment to PA/2019/1927 namely to amend the size of the detached garage at 11 Winterton Road, Winteringham, DN15 9NF: No negative comments were made.
- e) PA/2021/100: Notice of intention to fell a holly and prune two holly trees all within Winteringham's conservation area at The Hollies, 23 Silver Street, Winteringham, DN15 9ND: No negative comments were made.
- f) Consultation on the Draft Flood Risk Sequential and Exception test Supplementary planning document: No comments were made as it appeared to affect the North Bank.
- g) A1077 Road Closure Information: See the Ward Report for comments. Information regarding the road closure is to be put the Parish Council website and Winteringham Facebook page.
- h) Any other applications from the date of this agenda being sent out: PA/2021/61: Planning Permission to replace existing conservatory with a new single storey extension, repair damaged walls and roof, install roof lights, replace windows, make internal alterations and remove pebbledash render at The Orchard, 66 West End, Winteringham, DN15 9NS: No negative comments were made.
- i) Neighbourhood Plan: Cllr M. Blackburn is to finalise a questionnaire to go in the next edition of the Newsletter. There is still uncertainty over the effect the proposed White Paper will have on Neighbourhood Plans.

6. To report any new highways matters:

- a) Road Surfaces: The roads are in a bad state all over the Parish. They are to be monitored and reported to North Lincolnshire Council as needed.
- b) Street Lights: Ornamental Street Light: see the Ward Report.
- c) Pavements: The path on Jubilee Gardens is uneven and could be a trip hazard. Mark Thornborough is to look into it.
- d) Parish Footpaths: See the Ward Report. No further issues were discussed.

- e) Playing field and ASFW: The Councillors discussed the tree work that had been carried out in the Spinney. The Clerk is to contact Longhurst Housing regarding the fence panels and ensure a site visit is carried out.  
The Parish Council agreed that once the stumps have been removed that the Conservancy Group could put together a planting plan for the space.

#### 7. To hear the reports from representatives:

- a) NHW: There have been reports of car theft and damage in the local area.  
There are leaflets regarding fraud which are to be circulated to residents.  
b) Village Hall: Nothing new to report.  
c) Newsletter: It was agreed that a smaller newsletter should be put together for March 2021.

#### 8. To review any correspondence

The External Auditors report came back with no concerns. The Clerk is to circulate it to Councillors.

#### 9. Any other business

The Council discussed PA/2020/568, no further news has been heard.

It was confirmed that Chrissy Price will be carrying out ~~some planting in the stone planters around the Village.~~ Planting in the stone troughs in the Village in memory of her father in law, Cllr L. Hutchinson is going to use the In Bloom grant to plant up the rest of the planters in the Village

The wheelie bin on the playing field that is owned by the Parish Council doesn't have wheels and hasn't been emptied. The Clerk is to look into obtaining a new one and disposing of the old one.

#### 10. Key Messages
