### **Business of the meeting of the Parish Council**

#### **1. Apologies for absence**

The Parish Council agreed to extend the period of absence for meetings for Cllr I. Dowson so that he can continue to be on the Parish Council. Cllr M. Blackburn proposed an extension until July 2021, Cllr L. Hutchinson seconded and all were in favour.

#### **2. To review the minutes of the meeting held on 2<sup>nd</sup> March 2021**

The minutes of the meeting were approved as an accurate record once they had been amended to show that the bin was to go on Waterside not on Marsh Lane in item 9.

#### **3. To consider the Clerks report**

##### **a) Ongoing items:**

- The Clerk confirmed that all items were ongoing with nothing further to update on.
- The tennis net had been installed on the all weather surface pitch.

b) Environment Agency (EA) and Flooding: The Parish Council discussed the flood defence works at South Ferriby.

#### **4. To be updated on the financial report:**

a) To consider the monthly report: The Parish Council discussed the report and all payments were approved. The Clerk has received a remittance for the Spring in Bloom grant.

The Parish Council discussed setting aside money for grants for Parish community organisations.

#### **5. To consider the following planning applications:**

a) PA/ PA/2021/585: Listed building consent to replace all external doors and windows at The Hollies, 23 Silver Street, Winteringham, DN15 9ND: No negative comments were made.

The Parish Council were pleased that the building was being sympathetically renovated and the Parish Council supported the application.

- b) PA/2021/329: Notice of intention to fell seven trees and prune 13 of various species all within Winteringham's conservation area at The Hollies, 23 Silver Street, Winteringham, DN15 9ND: No negative comments were made.
- c) PA/2021/459: Notice of intention to fell four trees within Winteringham's conservation area at Laburnham Cottage, 23 Low Burgage, Winteringham, DN15 9PF: No negative comments were made.
- d) Any other applications from the date of this agenda being sent out: None were received. The Parish Councillors thanked the Ward Councillors for their work on PA/2019/568.
- e) Neighbourhood Plan: Cllr M. Blackburn is to finalise a questionnaire and explaining letter to go in the next edition of the Newsletter. The questionnaire is to gauge residents responses to see if a Neighbourhood Plan is needed.  
The Ward Councillors had made it clear that development within the Parish would be needed in the future. Questions regarding suitable sites for future development are to be included in the Neighbourhood Plan Questionnaire. Cllr M. Blackburn is to look into an online version of the questionnaire.

#### 6. To report any new highways matters:

- a) Road Surfaces: The roads are in a bad state all over the Parish. They are to be monitored and reported to North Lincolnshire Council as needed.
- b) Street Lights: Nothing to report.
- c) Pavements: It was agreed to collate a report of where the bins are in the Parish and what condition they are in. The Parish Council will assess where new bins are needed.  
The dog poo bin on Low Burgage is broken, the Clerk is to let North Lincolnshire Council know.  
The Parish Council are very happy with the verge cutting that has been carried out by Grove Groundwork and the Clerk is to pass the comments on.
- d) Parish Footpaths: the finger post on Cliff Road has fallen down into the verge. The Clerk is to let North Lincolnshire Council know.  
There had been a complaint regarding disturbed soil on PROW WINT316. Cllr D. Fagan confirmed that the conservancy group were responsible. They have apologised as it was done by mistake and they are awaiting a response from North Lincolnshire Council.  
The Clerk has let North Lincolnshire Council know about the damaged stile on the public footpath from Low Burgage to Marsh Lane and will chase this up as it has not yet been fixed.
- e) Playing field and AWSP: The Parish Council discussed the missing tennis poles for the other court. This is to be looked into further.

#### 7. To hear the reports from representatives:

- a) NHW: No comments were made.
- b) Village Hall: There is a meeting due next week and work is ongoing for the year end finances.
- c) Newsletter: It was agreed that adverts were to be paid upfront when being placed in the Newsletter.  
A piece about the vacancies on the Parish Council are to be included in the Newsletter.

#### 8. To review any correspondence

No other correspondence has been received.

#### 9. Any other business

- a) Cenotaph: Cllr D. Fagan is to send out a policy regarding items that are placed on the Cenotaph for the Councillors to read through.

The planters outside the shop have now been filled with plants, thanks was given to the Councillor and the Handyman for their work. Thanks was given to Cllr L. Fowler and the Handyman for the installation of the new benches around the parish.
