BUSINESS OF THE MEETING

2. To discuss the precept and grant money for financial year 2018-2019

The council discussed the grant conditions set out by North Lincolnshire Council. The community level services condition was queried and the Clerk is to find out further information so that the grant can be discussed at the next Parish Council meeting.

The council discussed the condition to carry out Neighbourhood Planning. The Chair confirmed that this will be discussed at the next meeting once councillors had read the document regarding Neighbourhood Planning. The Chair proposed that a parking strategy could be included in the Neighbourhood Plan.

The parish council discussed the budget and various cost cutting exercises. The following items were discussed in detail:

- It was discussed that village business's may be approached to see if they would contribute towards the planting around the village.
- The council discussed the work needed on the war memorial and the gate at the Church.
- It was agreed that a reserves policy of 5% of the Precept should be implemented.
- The Parish Council discussed the Neighbourhood Watches' request for money towards the hire of the hall, the council agreed that the money would be paid on the provision that the minutes of meetings are published as the work is being carried out using public money. Cllr P. Hatton proposed, S. Foston seconded and all agreed.

Cllr S. Foston confirmed the progress that LincsFibre were making in their plans to providing broadband in the area.
